

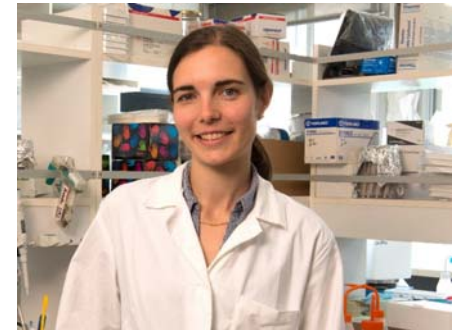

The Marie Heim-Vögtlin (MHV) Prize - worth 25,000 Swiss francs - is awarded once a year to a MHV-funded woman researcher by the Swiss National Science Foundation. It honours the quality of her research and her career progress. This year, exceptionally, the Prize will be awarded to two laureates.

Armelle Corpet, lecturer at the University Lyon 1 in France, receives the award in recognition of her research on senescence and cancer, which she conducted as a postdoc at University Hospital Zurich.

Anna Nele Meckler, group leader at the University of Bergen in Norway, is rewarded for her postdoctoral research in paleo-climatology at ETH Zurich, in which she reconstructs the climate of earlier times.
