| <p><b>Journal articles</b> as output of SNSF-funded research</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• OA publication in addition to publication in traditional medium (<b>Green Road</b>) or direct publication in OA journal (<b>Gold Road</b>)</li> <li>• Embargo period for Green Road: <b>6 months</b></li> </ul> <p>Grantees choose the most suitable journal. If the choice of journal creates legal obstacles with regard to an OA publication, grantees are obliged, if asked, to inform the SNSF and provide it with the relevant documents.</p> | <p><b>Journal articles</b> as output of SNSF-funded research</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Direct publication in OA journal (<b>Gold Road</b>)</li> <li>• No embargo period</li> </ul>  | <p><b>Journal articles</b> as output of non-SNSF-financed research are not funded.</p>   |
