<u>Michael Nielsen</u> is a pioneer of both quantum computing and open science, and co-author of one of the most cited physics texts of all time. His 2011 book <u>Reinventing Discovery</u> was one of the <u>FT's books of that year</u> , and helped to make open science a global issue. He is now based at the <u>Astera Institute</u> in California, where he works to develop tools and processes to speed up the way scientific discoveries are made. His talk will build on his <u>recent paper</u> on this theme, co-authored with Kanjun Qiu.
